

**ORDINANCE NO. 301-05  
CITY OF NEW MEADOW**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DOG CONTROL; AMENDING SECTION 6-2-1 AND SECTION 6-2-3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 290-04; CHANGING THE DEFINITION OF DOG FROM AGE THREE MONTHS TO AGE SIX MONTHS.**

**AMENDING SECTION 6-2-3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 290-04; CHANGING THE ANNUAL LICENSING DATE; IMPLEMENTING THE LICENSE EXPIRATION DATE AND GRACE PERIOD; AND ALLOWING A ONE TIME EXPIRATION EXTENSION TO DOG OWNERS COMPLYING WITH 05/06 LICENSING REGULATIONS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS, ADAMS COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** Amending 6-2-1

DEFINITIONS:

DOG: A dog of an age six months or older.

**Section 2:** Amending 6-2-3

LICENSE FEES:

EFFECTIVE DATE: March 1, 2007

Each license shall be issued annually between February 1 and March 31 for a term of one year. License fees shall be set by Council resolution. Each license shall be valid only for the dog for which it was issued and shall not be transferred or used for any other dog. Upon payment of such fee, the Clerk shall issue a license and a metal tag bearing the year of issuance and a number corresponding to the number on the license. The license shall state the date of issuance, the date of expiration, the amount paid, the name and address of the person to whom issued and the breed and sex of the dog.

The license shall state the date of expiration as February 28. A grace period for license purchases shall be March 1 through March 31 before the license fees double.

Licenses purchased in FY 05/06 shall not be due until March 2007.

**Section 3:** This ordinance shall be published once in full and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication.
