

CYCLING

Meadows Valley Loop

Start at the intersection of Hwy 95 and Hot Springs Road. Bike north to Zims Rd. then east to Campbell Rd. and south to Ferrel. Turn east & jaunt over to Cemetery Road. Go south then return west on Hwy 95 to Hot Springs Road— a 15 mile ride. Or to avoid the highway, cut off 4 miles & arrange a pick up along Cemetery Road.

Hot Springs Road to Zims

Start as above. At 5 mi. stop at Zims for a warm soak.



Raney Road to Whitney Ranch

Start at the Raney Rd/Hwy 55 Y and go south. A gentle country ride safer for younger children if supervised.

South End Road Loop

Park near the corner of South End Rd and Hwy 95. Bike south to Shortline Dr. then east. The road loops back on Walker Lane. Go west on Substation Road and return via South End to Hwy 95. An exquisite, easy 7.5 miles.

Weiser River Trail

An 84 mile long gravel trail extending to Weiser. Begin at the Wye Trailhead parking area 5 miles west of town.

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

SWIMMING & BOATING

Goose Lake & Campground

Drive east to Brundage Mountain Rd. Turn and drive 11 miles. Pavement turns to gravel at about 4 miles.

Zims Hot Springs

North of town. Turn west on Zims Road.

Lost Valley Reservoir

Drive west on Hwy 95 to Lost Valley Road. Reservoir is about 2.5 miles west. Rustic camp spots available.

CANOEING

Little Salmon River

Take HWY 95 north about 4 miles to Zims Road. Turn west and follow the "S" bend to bridge over the Little Salmon River. Park along the road or ask at Zims for permission to park in campground. Shuttle a 2nd vehicle to the take out just before Smoky Boulder Rd in parking area off Hwy 95.

WILDLIFE VIEWING




Wetlands Areas

North of town off Hwy 95 between 6-10 miles. Park in pull outs only. Respect private property.

Meadows Valley Loop

See Cycling section. Many of our cycling roads offer great wildlife viewing of elk, deer, moose, coyote, fox, and a plethora of birds including sand hill cranes, herons, hawks, eagles, and the little guys as well.

CAMPING RVING & TENTING



Packer John's Campground

East of town off Hwy 55. At 3 miles turn north down an alley-like road. In $\frac{1}{2}$ mile find a rustic tent & RV camp. Perfect for bicyclists heading toward McCall.

Meadows RV Park

East of town about 2.5 miles and north off Hwy 55. Showers and laundry available.

Zims Hot Springs & Campground (RV & Tenting)

North of town. Take Zims Rd west off Hwy 95.

Last Chance Campground

Nestled in the woods 4 miles east. Turn north and meander 2.25 miles down this road. You can't miss it.
