

# Resolution # TBD-2015

A Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City of New Meadows, Adams County, Idaho, to establish the process for triggering when the mayor may order the streets to be watered.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of New Meadows has determined the need at times to better the air quality within the City of New Meadows;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of New Meadows, as follows:

The mayor may order the roads to be watered by the New Meadows Public Works Department when the following conditions are met;

- a) The dust palliative applied required stay dry time has been met or exceeded; or,
- b) The dust palliative applied, requires the roadway to be rewetted; and,
- c) The air quality in the community is “Real-Time Air Monitored” at the “Orange – Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups” as monitored on the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality Real-Time Air Monitoring site in McCall, until which time an Air Monitoring Site is located inside the New Meadows corporate limits; and,
- d) At least one citizen has complained about fugitive dust in writing to the city or has contacted the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality and IDEQ has contacted the City of New Meadows in writing via USPS Mail, email, fax or has called New Meadows City Hall to register the complaint on behalf of the New Meadows citizen ; and,
- e) At least one council member concurs the roadways need to be watered; and
- f) The weather forecast does not indicate moisture in the following three days.

The cost of the bulk water, fuel to operate the machinery to water the roadway, and the wages shall be levied against the street department account for dust abatement.

THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.
