An explanation on the calculation of the contributions for your jurisdiction follows. The City Sponsor Contributions are based on .05 cents per capital with a minimum of \$50 and a maximum of \$500. County Sponsor Contributions are \$500. Large Cities are \$300. Soil Conservation Districts' are \$150. All others are \$50.


RC&D Mission:
