Agenda Item 1) Roll Call – Welcome- Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Tony Koberstein called the meeting to order at 2:00PM. Mayor Koberstein and Council Members; Julie Good, Brad Steiner, Darbey Edwards, and Shannon Fairchild were present. City Clerk / Treasurer Jacob “Mac” Qualls and Office Assistant Kim Jackson were also present. There were no public in attendance.

Agenda Item 2) Budget Workshop

a. Council members discussed the FY 2015-2016 city council budget priority items. Items were marked in order of priority and some items were marked as expenditures if grant funds are available. There was discussion concerning capital projects that might be able to be accomplished using community volunteers. The painting of the city hall and the adoption of stray dogs if the city pound is not available were discussed as possible volunteer projects. The remodel of the conference room was discussed but would only be accomplished if it is bid at or below the budgeted cost. Several of the budgeted items were marked “if possible” and will be discussed after Qualls has finished totaling the revenue and expenses according to the Council’s stated priority. The ACSO contract was discussed and the Council asked that a representative from the Adams County Sheriff’s Department be invited to the next City Council meeting to discuss the availability of reports from ACSO to the City Council.
