**Agenda Item 1: Roll Call – Welcome – Pledge of Allegiance:**

**Agenda Item 2: Public Input (Decorum):**

**Agenda Item 3: Road / Street Priority Workshop:**

The Council and staff discussed priorities for future road and street projects. Buys stated that with the success of the paving of Peterson Memorial, he did not want to lose momentum. North and South Heigho were designated as the most traveled streets through New Meadows. The intersections at Virginia Street are highly impacted with craters due to cars stopping and turning at those intersections. The Council chose to set the rebuilding and paving of intersections at Virginia, beginning with North and South Heigho, as the top priority. They discussed creating a timeline so that business owners would be able to plan ahead and possibly pave their parking areas at the same time. They also discussed having a plan to educate the public on the project and to show the progress at the same time. Buys will prepare a cost estimate for a 150-foot section of road. The Council chose to add an agenda item to their next meeting regarding priorities for this project.
