

EMERGENCY CITY OF NEW MEADOWS CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Agenda Item 1 – Roll Call

Current Situation:

Mayor Edwards stated that the disaster declaration can be ongoing and doesn't necessarily mean a lot of relief. City Clerk Qualls stated that the state would share costs 50/50 and will include wages. Qualls read the Disaster Resolution letter. All Council Members are to sign the letter, and Qualls will deliver it to the County to be recorded.
